In order to complete the online application, the following information will be required.

1. Applicant and Academic Information

- Applicant Name, Mailing Address, Email, and Phone Number
- Name of BC post-secondary institution you are attending and graduate program

2. Summary of Research

- Provide a title, description, and abstract of your project (250 words max).
- What problem(s) does your research address? How will your findings contribute to a solution?
- How does this course of study relate to the objectives of HCTF and the legacy of Al Martin?

3. Contribution to Conservation

- What conservation issue does your research address?
- How does your area of study specifically relate to the objectives of the Habitat Conservation Trust Foundation and the legacy of Al Martin?
- How will your findings contribute to a solution or advance conservation in BC?
- How will you apply your research?

4. Goals, Skills, and Leadership

- What motivates you to complete graduate studies?
- Describe your career path, and where you see yourself in 5-10 years?
- Describe a moment, influence, or experience that attracted you to this field of study.
- How will this early-career experience position you for longer term goals, both personal and professional?
- Why are you a strong candidate for the Al Martin HCTF Conservation Fellowship?
- How have or will you develop leadership skills and abilities to achieve your goals and advance conservation? Please provide specific examples.

5. Other & References

- How do you plan to use the award money? (not scored)
- The HCTF requires a minimum of 2 references who are knowledgeable of you and your graduate work and who are able to speak to how your graduate work and thesis align with the purpose of the Al Martin HCTF Conservation Fellowship.
- The reference requests are done in the online HCTF Survey Apply application system. Each reference you add will be sent a link to provide their reference. This can be done as a file upload or they can choose to complete a form. Note: Email letters of reference will not be accepted.
