Year 3 Project Report Kootenay Region

Project Summary

The Kootenay River Guardian Program included angler education, angler compliance checks and angler (Creel) surveys on 8 classified waters, contacting approximately 960 anglers in 2023-24. WCT inventory (density/abundance estimates) was conducted on 2 systems (6 indexes) and BT inventory (primarily redd counts) were conducted on >25 indexes in 7 systems. Habitat evaluations were conducted in both WCT and BT systems where inventory projects were completed. Indepth summary data from this program cycle was provided for an AMP review process which will inform changes to Angling Managment Plans and recommendations via the Kootenay Angling Management Plan Review process. This is an ongoing consultative process to continually adapt and improve management on classified waters. Finally, RG's presented data to stakeholder clubs/groups, peers, etc. to educate public and promote both the benefits of the program and long term management objectives for species viability and angler opportunity. All of these components played a vital part in informing proactive management decisions with the goal of balancing diverse and sustained quality angler opportunities with long term conservation of wild stock wct and bt fisheries.

However, the most significant impact to Region 4 program delivery was the reduction to funding until year 3 of the project cycle (2023) due to reduced angler licence sales and shortfalls in budget. Overall - challenges were not significant and the program was delivered as planned.
